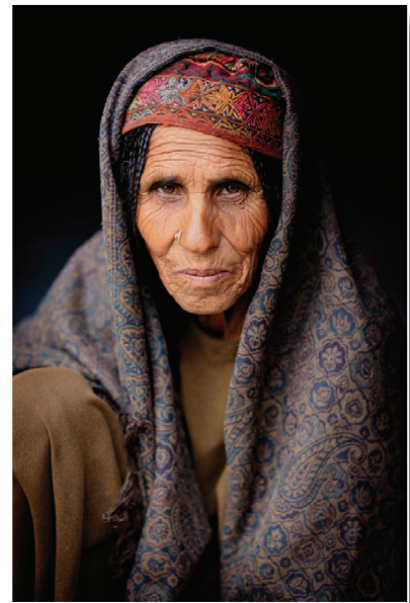
Bio:
